Section 4. First Aid Measures

First Aid Measures for Accidental:

General advice: Move out of dangerous area. Consult a physician. Show this safety data sheet to the doctor in attendance. Do not leave the victim unattended.

Inhalation: Call a physician or poison control center immediately. If unconscious place in recovery position and seek medical advice.

Skin contact: Immediate medical treatment is necessary as untreated wounds from corrosion of the skin heal slowly and with difficulty. If on skin, rinse well with water. If on clothes, remove clothes.

Eye contact: Small amounts splashed into eyes can cause irreversible tissue damage and blindness. In the case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice. Continue rinsing eyes during transport to hospital. Remove contact lenses. Protect unharmed eye. Keep eye wide open while rinsing. If eye irritation persists, consult a specialist.

Ingestion: Clean mouth with water and drink afterwards plenty of water. Keep respiratory tract clear. Do NOT induce vomiting. Do not give milk or alcoholic beverages. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If symptoms persist, call a physician. Take victim immediately to hospital.

<u>Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed:</u> May cause an allergic skin reaction. Causes serious eye damage. Suspected of causing cancer. Causes severe burns.

Section 5. Fire-fighting Measures

Suitable Extinguishing Media: Carbon dioxide, foam, dry chemical, water fog.

Unsuitable extinguishing media: High volume water jet.

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Special Protective Equipment and Precautions for Fire-fighters: Use personal protective equipment. Wear self-contained breathing apparatus for firefighting if necessary, with a full face-piece operated in positive pressure mode to protect against potential harmful and/or irritating fumes. Use water to keep fire exposed containers cool.

Section 6. Accidental Release Measures

Personal Precautions, Protective Equipment and Emergency Procedures: No action shall be taken involving any personal risk or without suitable training. Evacuate surrounding areas. Keep unnecessary and unprotected personnel from entering. Do not walk through spilled material. Shut off all ignition sources. No flares, smoking or flames in hazard area. Provide adequate ventilation. Wear appropriate respirator when ventilation is inadequate. Put on appropriate personal protective equipment (see Section 8).

Environmental Precautions: Prevent product from entering drains. Prevent further leakage or spillage if safe to do so. If the product contaminates rivers and lakes or drains inform respective authorities.

Methods and Material for Containment and Cleaning Up: Move containers from spill area. Dike and absorb with inert absorbent material (*e.g.*, sand) and collect in a suitable, closed and labeled container. Wash the spill area with water and detergent. Dispose of in accordance with applicable local and federal environmental control regulations.

Section 7. Handling and Storage

Precautions for Safe Handling: Put on appropriate personal protective equipment (see Section 8). Workers should wash hands and face before eating, drinking and smoking. Remove contaminated clothing and protective equipment before entering eating areas. Persons with a history of skin sensitization problems should not be employed in any process in which this product is used. Do not get in eyes or on skin or clothing. Do not ingest. Avoid breathing vapor or mist. Keep in the original container or an approved alternative made from a compatible material, kept tightly closed when not in use. Do not reuse empty container.

Conditions for safe storage including any incompatibilities: Store in a cool, dry place with adequate ventilation. Keep in original containers. Store in tightly closed containers to prevent moisture absorption and loss of volatiles. Store away from heat and open flame.

Appropriate Engineering Controls: Ventilation must be adequate for most operations. **Personal Protective Equipment:**
